At the end of 2025 Xango Music welcomed four new labels from Germany for distribution in the BeNeLux: Nordic Notes, CPL-Music, BESTE! UNTERHALTUNG and Folk Galore.

Nordic Notes, which presents folk, jazz and pop from the Nordic countries, BESTE! UNTERHALTUNG, which is dedicated to Franconian music, CPL-Music with a focus on folk and world music, and Folk Galore, which runs a magazine in addition to its label. Immerse yourself in the fascinating world of traditional and contemporary music, including global pop, from all corners of the globe. From vinyl records to CDs, covering the broad spectrum of folk and global music.

Wor and Kongero have joined forces for an extraordinary project with Songbooks Live: exploring commonalities and contrasts between their different musical traditions and repertoires. Both bands delved into historical archives with one goal: to find songs suitable for a Belgian-Swedish collaboration and letting timeless emotions and exquisite tunes speak through their own arrangements. <u>Listen.</u>

Bringing sound tableaus that float freely between the Bosphorus and India, Soolmaan weaves flute, sax, ney, cello, piano, and tamburello into an imaginary folklore infected by jazz. Spanning influences from Ottoman makam to Indian raga, Kashgul is a vibrant, boundary-crossing soundscape rich with improvisation. <u>Listen.</u>

With a voice as commanding and enchanting as an opera performance, Kaito's masterful scansion and storytelling draw the listener into timeless truths. he plays an array of instruments—calabash, mouth bow, Peul flute, toutlé flute, and the tama, a drum known for mimicking human speech. Listen.

With a voice both powerful and intimate, Luisa she sings and narrates-in the language of her emotions: Sicilian, weaving together original lyrics, translations, ancient poetry, and autobiographical fragments. Truvatura is a collection of emotional artifacts: treasure-songs that Luisa Briguglio entrusts to anyone willing to listen. Because sometimes the real prize is not what we find, but what we become in seeking it. Listen.

Inspired by the Thomas Hardy poem, Transformations, Eliza Marshall unveils her debut solo album Eternal Birth. The album reveres the natural world as a living archive of our ancestors, expressing the unseen but powerful bonds we share with the Earth, with those who came before us, and the new generations. <u>Listen.</u>

His music history count legendary bands like Orchestra A de Bamako, Orchestre National de Bamako and Super Biton de Ségou. Sissoko uses irony in texts critical to the absurdities faced by immigrants in the post colonial realities

On his new album he explores new horizons for his instrument in improvised music. Together with his Berlin-based trio, he conquers the peaks of balafon possibilities one by one, wandering between groovy African rhythms, spectacular polyphony and elements of jazz, and combining them into a fusion.

At the helm once again is guitarist and producer Justin Adams. Congolese rapper Youssoupha and Rwandan French rapper Gael Faye make guest appearances alongside a stellar band, which includes John Baggott on keyboard (Massive Attack, Robert Plant), Billy Fuller (Robert Plant) on bass and Howey Gill on drums. <u>Listen.</u>

The revival of vinyl has given the musicians of Muddy Gurdy the opportunity to release this compilation of their three albums. Given that LPs were undoubtedly the key vehicles for the discovery, dissemination and recognition of blues music in their day, the trio's approach was obvious: here we find their sincerity, their erudition and their respect for this repertoire, which they generously illustrate in their own way. <u>Listen.</u>



Maria Kalaniemi & Pekko Kappi: Tareportens Parla – Kyynelportin Helmi – Tears To Pearls AKEROCD 29 / 6430017003000 / label: Akero / format: CD / Finland–Folk (street date: 9-Jan-'26)

Maria Kalaniemi's meditative tunes on accordion and singing, and of Pekko Kappi on jouhikko, a Finnish bowed lyre, and singing. Maria Kalaniemi is a accordion artist. She is one of the pioneers of contemporary folk music. Pekko Kappi is a jouhikko artist. He is an ethnomusicologist specializing in folk song traditions by training.

With Symphony of Self, Gao Hongs artistry soars to new heights as she composes, orchestrates and performs the pipa in four concertos-masterfully weaving ancient Pudong pipa traditions into the richness of a full Western orchestra. Recorded at the legendary Abbey Road Studios with the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra, her four pipa concertos forge a striking cultural fusion, giving the Chinese lute a bold new voice in classical music.

A long-awaited release that features the late guitar master at his most lyrical and inventive was recorded in January 2017 but held back until now. This session led by vibraphonist Tony Miceli is a poignant tribute to Vic Juriss boundless musicality and deep connection to the jazz tradition. Inspired by the spirit of Django Reinhardt and the Hot Club legacy, the quartet reimagines classic French repertoire with fresh arrangement.



Matt Garrity: Suits And Scotches (street date: January 9th, 2026)

The debut album of drummer Matt Garrity, a long-standing figure in the New York jazz scene whose artistry has matured over three decades of collaboration with legends such as Joe Lovano, Vincent Herring, and Joel Forrester. Suits And Scotches captures the essence of Garritys musical journey, featuring original compositions and fresh interpretations of jazz standards performed by his seasoned quartet.



Dave Pietro: The Butterfly Effect (street date January 16th, 2026)

Following the critical acclaim of The Talisman (SCCD 31955), alto saxophonist Dave Pietro returns with The Butterfly Effect. A veteran of ensembles led by Maria Schneider, Toshiko Akiyoshi, and Gil Evans, Pietro continues to command attention as a composer and bandleader whose work is both intellectually rigorous and emotionally resonant.



John McNeil & Tom Harrel: Look To The Sky (street date: January 23rd, 2026) G 1128 / 0716043112814 / label: SteepleChase Records / format: LP / USA – Jazz

Originally released in 1979 and reissued on CD in 1996 with bonus material, this album stands as a vibrant snapshot of two masterful trumpeters-John McNeil and Tom Harrell-at a pivotal moment in modern jazz. Now, for the first time, this landmark session returns in stunning 24bit/96kHz remastered fidelity on heavyweight 180g vinyl, preserving the warmth and swing of the original analog tapes.
